Does your church have a Disaster Preparedness Plan? Who will do what in the case of a disaster?

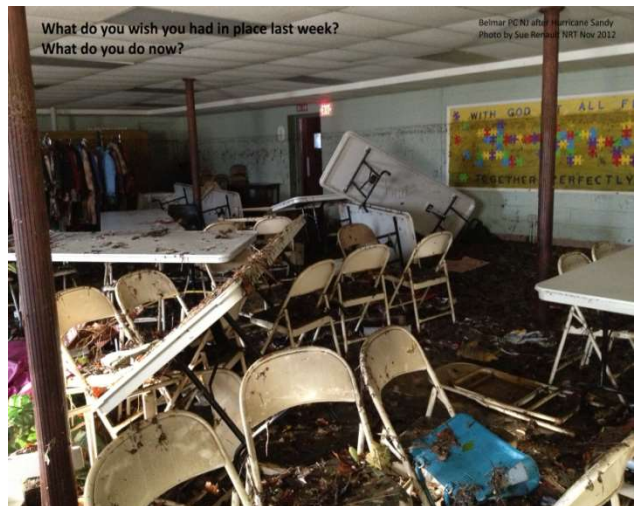
Is it time for a Preparedness Plan to be created or updated. Does your congregation need help in getting started with your plan?
